**Position title:** Assistant Professor in Physical Therapy

San Francisco State University, Department of Physical Therapy invites applicants for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position beginning August 2017.

The department seeks individuals with content expertise in pediatric or adult neurological rehabilitation, adult musculoskeletal rehabilitation, adult acute care rehabilitation, human growth and development, or basic sciences of physical therapy.

The Department of Physical Therapy at SFSU offers a Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree jointly with the University of California, San Francisco. Faculty and resources needed for the DPT degree program are shared between the two campuses. There are currently 5 full-time faculty at SFSU in addition to a number of part-time lecturers.

**Qualifications:**

Candidates should have a Ph.D. or equivalent academic degree (Ed.D.; D.Sc.; DPTSc.) Candidates should have a California PT license or eligibility.

Candidates should have a strong background in movement dysfunctions, patient rehabilitation, and education.

Candidates must demonstrate the ability to teach courses in areas of content expertise in the curricular areas of the DPT program, such as pediatric or adult neurological rehabilitation, adult musculoskeletal rehabilitation, adult acute care rehabilitation, human growth and development, or basic sciences of physical therapy.

Candidates must have an active record of scholarship related to their specialty area. Excellence in teaching and scholarship must be demonstrated.

Candidates must be able to work cooperatively, and show evidence of interpersonal skills and collegiality.

Candidates are preferred who have experience teaching DPT students and research experience. Candidates are preferred who have experience in multicultural settings.

**Responsibilities:** The position requires graduate teaching in the DPT degree program, mentoring and advising graduate students, developing an active ongoing scholarship program in an area of specialty, and ongoing committee and service assignments. 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**Rank and salary:** Assistant Professor. Salary commensurate with qualifications and experience. The CSU provides generous health, retirement and other benefits.
